

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

Gains in Reading:

- Schools participating in the reading program show an average of 15% increase in reading scores
- 10 of the 18 primary centers have now incorporated the intensive reading program
- 735 teachers have participated in professional development in teaching reading, for a total of \$1.5 M invested over nine years
- The number of students reading on or above grade level has increased (See chart far right)
- Wilson Reading System© administrators have invited South Bend Schools to be the first partner organization for the reading training in Indiana
